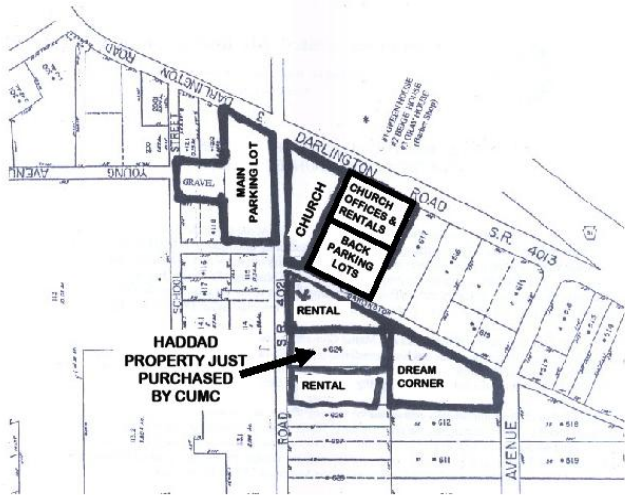




HERE WE GO...HERE WE GROW...BUILDING FOR CHIRST!!!

We are blessed to have with us, Mitch McVicker in concert in our sanctuary on Thursday evening, October 2nd. Mitch is a Dove Award winner for his song in 1999 "My Deliverer". He also penned some famous songs with the late Rich Mullins for Amy Grant and Michael W. Smith. It was the late Rich Mullins who introduced Mitch to the contemporary Christian music world as he traveled, did concerts and wrote songs with Mullins for 2 years. Rich Mullins is famous for his song "Awesome God". However, in 1977 tragedy struck. As the two traveled to a concert, their vehicle overturned and Rich Mullins was killed. Mitch McVicker was left with serious injuries and in a comma for 6 months. During his two year recovery period, thousands of people around the country rallied to pray for him. Where he is today is nothing short of a miracle. He has recorded songs with DC Talk, Mercy Me, Ray Boltz and recently been on tour with Rebecca St. James.
