O the joy of full salvation! Glory, glory, to his name! (Refrain)

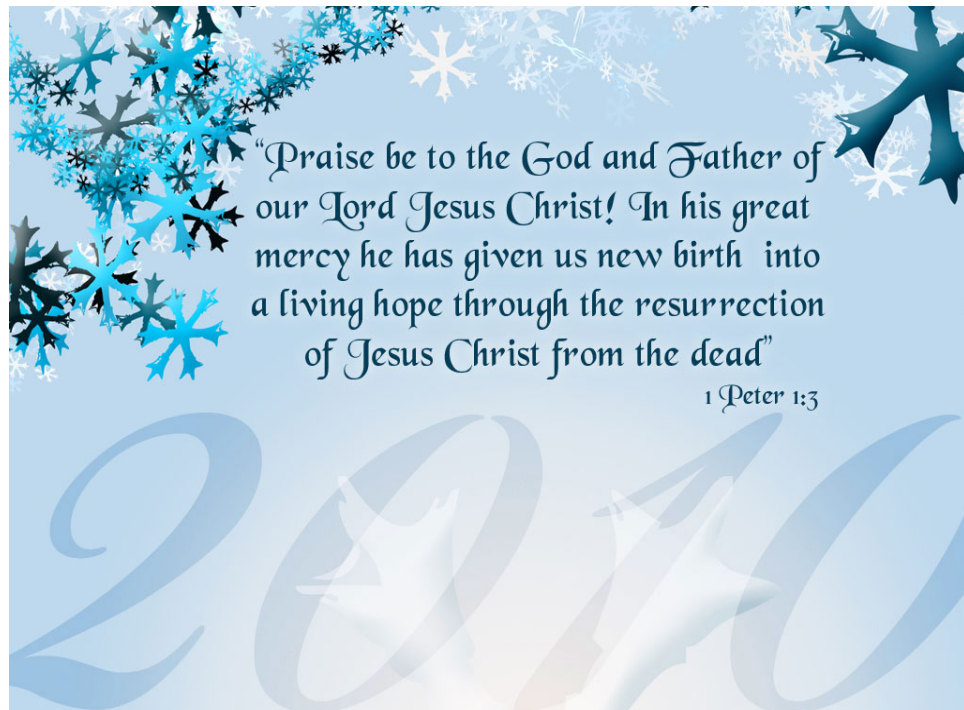
