Community Life Center Update

Through the Christmas holiday season your Bricks and
Mortar team has been active. We have retained the services
of Jeff Frye to be our engineer and Pingle-Nero to do our
surveying. We have received the "next step" approval from
the Chippewa Planning Commission and are in the process
of updating the physical layout of the campus. We are
addressing several standard questions, i.e. water runoff,
"green" areas, and parking. These items have all been taken
into consideration before, but could not be definitively
answered until we hired an engineer. One change is
noteworthy. We will be keeping the Dream Corner Youth
Center, but we will be removing the front house. The house
only has a few offices, needs a lot of repairs, and we need
the space for parking.

January 12th we interviewed with several
contractors and banking institutions. We will soon be
selecting an architect. Our ground-breaking date will be
announced as soon as we know it. Final approvals from the
Township must be obtained, after which we will obtain the
necessary building permits. We anticipate a late spring
ground-breaking to be followed by an active summer of
construction.

As more details become known to us we will pass
them on to the congregation. This project belongs to you!
The Bricks and Mortar Committee are merely your servants.
After 10 + years of planning we sincerely feel that this is the
year for us to build our Community Life Center. Thank you
for your spiritual and financial support.
