**Chippewa UMC Community Life Center Update**

The Bricks and Mortar Team has been hard at work behind  
the scenes holding several meetings in order to continue the  
process of making the Chippewa UMC CLC a reality. Four  
builders and their proposals were presented, and an architect  
offering their renderings of the proposed building. The  
Airport Contractors, Inc. of Crescent, PA has been awarded  
the preliminary contract to build the CLC. The Bricks and  
Mortar Team will be meeting with their architect to design  
the building and make up the drawings. These drawings will  
be necessary to go to the Township for final approval, to the  
Butler District Committee on Building and Location and  
also to the banks for final loan approval. When all of this is  
completed the Bricks and Mortar Team will be going to the  
Administrative Board of the CUMC for approval. After  
these drawings have been completed we will know exactly  
what the CLC will look like on the inside, outside and how  
much the building will cost. Bricks and Mortar will be soon  
updating the congregation with several presentations. The  
engineer, Tom Frye, has been working with the Bricks and  
Mortar Team who has gone to the Chippewa Township  
Board of Supervisors for preliminary approval. A site plan  
is being done with all the necessary information: water run  
off, parking, traffic patterns etc. When the site plan is  
completed, with all the approvals from the District,  
Township, bank and Administrative Board is completed,  
Bricks and Mortar will be making a presentation to the  
congregation with all the particulars on the CLC. We will  
be excited to announce the ground breaking date, the  
beginning of construction and the projected complete date.

The front house of Dream Corner will be torn down with the  
offices of Youth Pastor and Administrative Assistant being  
housed in the CLC. The Dream Corner back house Teen  
Center will continue to be used along with the CLC for  
ministry of the church and youth.

We thank the Bricks and Mortar Team whose members have  
been spending countless hours working on the necessary  
steps and process of making the CLC a reality.
