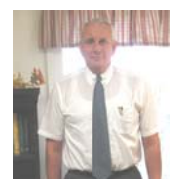

BRICKS AND MORTAR UPDATE ON PLANS OF CHIPPEWA UMC COMMUNITY LIFE CENTER...

We have accomplished through God's leading the following steps:

1. Church conference approval to move ahead and present final plans
2. Preliminary approval from Chippewa Township Planning Commission
3. Preliminary approval from District Building and Location Team
4. Preliminary approval from Township Board of Supervisor

Most Recent Steps:

1. Approval from District Building and Location Team
2. Approval from Administrative Board
3. Approval from Huntington Bank
4. Affirmation and Support from Congregation after presenting detailed plans

Future Steps Coming:

1. Site plans, detailed building plans submitted to Chippewa Township for final approval July 13th.
2. Signing loan papers with bank
3. Signing contract with Airport Contractors
4. Ground breaking date to be set
5. Construction period
6. Grand Opening
