1. Approval from Chippewa Township Planning Commission & Board of Supervisors on July 14.
2. Approval from District Building and Location Team
3. Approval from Administrative Board
4. Pre-Approval from a local bank
5. Affirmation and Support from Congregation after presenting detailed plans
6. Finalized the loan with S & T Bank
7. Signed contract with Airport Contractors

Future Steps Coming:

1. Ground breaking date to be set
2. Construction period
3. Grand Opening
