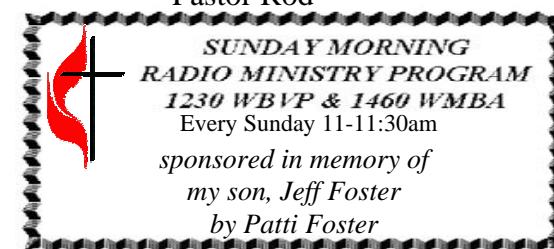
WELCOME TO WEEKEND WORSHIP
