**October Monthly Mission**-Monthly Mission is  
designated to go towards Imagine No Malaria - Nets  
Plus . Simply put, malaria kills. Nets can save lives.  
Some on the harsh realities about malaria:  
FACT: it is preventable, but causes nearly 500 million  
illnesses each year and kills more than 1 million of  
those who become infected.  
FACT: Ninety percent of the deaths occur in Africa,  
where the disease is a leading killer of children. Every  
30 seconds a child in Africa dies from malaria.  
FACT: Malaria is the #1 killer of refugees in Africa. 2/3  
of the 33 million refugees worldwide live in malaria  
endemic countries. So, as engaged citizens, what can we  
do to help? In the poorest parts of the world, window  
screens are lacking, anti-malaria drugs are expensive,  
and a malaria vaccine does not exist. Insecticide-treated  
bed nets in these areas are the most cost effective way  
to prevent malaria. Bed nets use a simple but effective  
prevention approach; eliminate contact with  
mosquitoes, eliminate malaria. Please give what you
